EPL PLAYERS TO WATCH THIS SEASON

SON HEUNG-MIN
(TOTTENHAM HOTSPUR)



Son will be central to Spurs title challenge this season.

The South Korean finished the 2021/22 EPL as the joint leading goal scorer with 23 goals and he has the pace and eye for goal to trouble any team in the world.

Spurs attacking style of football suits Son and he can combine with Harry Kane to produce a deadly strike force duo.

Son provided an assist during Spurs opening game against Southampton on the weekend and it will not be long until he gets his name on the scoresheet.

Son won the 2019 Puskas award for the goal of the year which saw him run 70 yards and beat five defenders before finding the back of the net in a match against Burnley.

Son has scored 93 goals in 233 Premier League appearances and he is a fan favourite among the Tottenham faithful and he will look to walk in the footsteps of legends by guiding Spurs to a first ever trophy in 14 years.

DAVID DE GEA
(MANCHESTER UNITED)



David de Gea has managed to keep 130 clean sheets in 378 Premier League appearances, and he won the Golden Glove in 2017/18

The Spaniard knows what it takes to lift the holy grail of English soccer having won the Premier League in 2013 and new coach Erik ten Hag will look to De Gea to organize the defence and make some match winning saves.

Manchester United had their worst ever Premier League season in 2021/22 and De Gea has the leadership skills to assist Erik ten Hag in rebuilding a squad that are capable of challenging for a top four finish.

Cristiano Ronaldo started on the bench for United in the opening match of their 2022/23 Premier League campaign and if Ronaldo stays at United, these two players will have a vital role to play for the Red Devils.

MOHAMED SALAH
(LIVERPOOL)



Egypt did not qualify for the 2022 FIFA World Cup and Mohamed Salah will be looking to make up for this disappointment with inspirational performances throughout the 2022/23 Premier League.

The 2021/22 Premier League ended in heartbreak for Liverpool as they missed out on winning the title by just one point.

Sadio Mane has left Liverpool for Bayern Munich which makes Salah even more important this season and with 121 goals in 194 Premier League appearances for Liverpool, there is no doubt that Salah has the ability to guide Liverpool to the summit of the Premier League.

Salah scored in the Reds opening game of the season against Fulham and he will not be happy with the dropped points as a result of the 2-2 draw.

As one star departs Liverpool there is another legend in the making in Darwin Nunez and Salah will be looking to combine with Nunez and continue Liverpool's legacy as one of the best attacking teams in the world.

EDOUARD MENDY
(CHELSEA)



Edouard Mendy had a breakthrough season in 2021/22

The Chelsea shot stopper became the first African player to win the FIFA goalkeeper player of the year award.

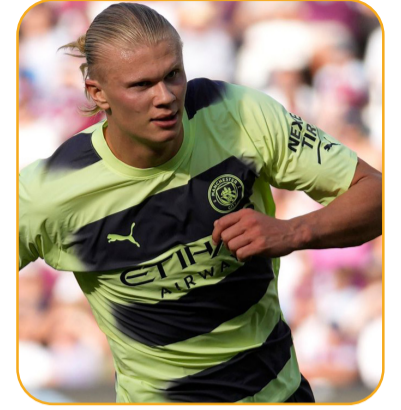
Mendy kept 27 clean sheets and conceded just 34 goals in 51 games and he was the hero for Senegal with a save in the penalty shootouts of the 2021 African Cup of Nations final which earned the Lions of Teranga their first ever continental trophy.

A few weeks later Mendy booked Senegal their ticket to the 2022 FIFA World Cup in Qatar after saving a penalty during the penalty shootout victory against Egypt in World Cup qualifying.

Mendy is full of confidence and he kept a clean sheet against Everton during the Blues opening game of the season which they won 1-0

Goalkeepers win matches and in Mendy Chelsea have one of the best goalkeepers in the world.

ERLING HAALAND
(MANCHESTER CITY)



Erling Haaland announced himself on the Premier League stage for Manchester City by scoring a brace in a 2-0 victory against West Ham United on the weekend.

Haaland is a threat in every aspect of the game. The Norwegian stands at 194 centimetres tall which makes him dangerous in the air and he is a physically imposing player and he also has an eye for goal and good pace.

Haaland has set himself high expectations in the Premier League and he has warned future opponents that he can get even better.

"I can get better at everything. As a young player, playing for Pep Guardiola, playing for the best club in England in Man City, I have to keep developing and get better at a lot."- Said Haaland.

Haaland scored 22 goals in 24 matches during the 2021/2022 Bundesliga season and he has an entertaining personality. If Haaland continues his goal scoring form Manchester City will be hard to stop this season.
